

Agiorgitiko (2007)

Appellation of Origin Nemea of High Quality



Type: Dry red wine

Varieties : Agiorgitiko Greek grape variety

Origin: Vineyards in the mountain region of Nemea, in the Communes of Asprokambos and Psari in the Peloponese.

Vinification: Red wine vinification with long maceration of four weeks. During the first week, the temperature remains below 20 oC, and then rises to 30 oC. The new wine undergoes malolactic fermentation in oak barrels, where it remains and matures for at least 12 months

Alcoholic strength: 13 %

Tasting notes : A Red wine with reflections of aromas of fruit and flowers, a harmonious flavour and rich aftertaste. It is a full bodied red with aromas of cherries, cloves and vanilla.

Gastronomy –All the dishes which stir a desire for a fine red wine like lamb, vegetables and white meats.
