Single Vineyard "Kryovrisi"

Regional Wine of Atalanti Valley



Type: White, Dry

Varieties: Sauvignon Blanc

Origin: Exclusively from 1,8he from the **single vineyard 'Kryovrisi'**, at the foothills of mount Galanos, part of the privately owned vineyards of Domaine Hatzimichalis in Atalanti Valley, Central Greece. From a happy coincidence, the subsoil of the single vineyard 'Kryovrisi' where the Sauvignon Blanc is cultivated, is similar to that of the region of Pouilly in Loire Valley. The typical varietal character of the wine reflects the vineyard 'Kryovrisi' where it grows.

Vinification: Matures in small barrels for 21 weeks before bottling.

Alcoholic strength: 13% Vol.

Ageing potential is within the first 6 years after the harvest

Tasting notes Bright light yellow colour with green hues. Expressive varietal aromas of green apple, ripe kiwi and melon on a background of fresh cut grass and flint compose an exuberant personality. In the mouth the refreshing acidity unfolds daintily, leading to an aromatic and fresh aftertaste.

Gastronomy – *Drink it with fresh salads, seafood, fresh oysters, grilled fish, poultry and vegetables, even with asparagus. Also ideal choice to accompany the recipes of Indian cuisine based on coriander and of course goat cheese.*
